

Mardi-Mangrove Link Linking Wyong River to Mangrove Creek Dam



Works location and traffic update From 20 June 2011

- Wet weather and flooding last week has caused damage to Yarramalong Road and Bunning Creek Bridge
 approaches. Crews will be working in various locations along the length of Yarramalong Road under stop-go
 and traffic light control. Please follow directions and drive carefully.
- Restoration of the section of road between Kidmans Lane and Wyong Creek Public School will recommence this week. Work in this section is near completion.
- There may be some minor delays to demobilise the Horizontal Directional Drilling site west of Stinsons Lane.
 Stop-go traffic controls will be in place at Gates R and S.
- Spoil removal continues along the construction corridor. Intermittent stop-go controls may be in place for the movement of large trucks at gates L and V.
- Project money has been allocated to carry out repairs to the sections of Yarramalong Road that have been damaged by construction of the pipeline. Residents can be assured the road will be restored to a strength and capacity similar to the original pavement in new condition.
- Council is monitoring deterioration of the sections of road impacted by pipelaying.
- Residents are reminded that signage and reduced speed limits are in place where there are no lines marked.
 A full assessment of line marking will be made at the end of the project and line markings will be reinstated under current safety guidelines.

A **reduced speed** limit of 60kph (down from 80kph) applies outside the main John Holland site office at 148 Yarramalong Road west to near Red Hill Road. **Working hours** are 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 8am-1pm Saturday. Priority access is given to **emergency vehicles** and school buses.
